Ipswich Hospice Care (IHC) has been providing end of life palliative care for inpatients for over fifteen years. In addition, for the past six years, members of the Ipswich Community have also been cared for by offering Bereavement, Grief and Loss Support. Ipswich Hospice has four year accreditation through ACHS and holds a Private Hospital Licence.

Twenty four hour in patient care is provided by one RN and one EN/AIN. A second Registered Nurse is always on call if assistance/advice is required. Medical care is provided by the patient's own GP & is overseen by a Palliative Care Consultant.

An opportunity exists to join this team as a (casual) Registered Nurse to replace permanent staff on leave (planned and sickness).

It is highly desirable to have experience in end of life, palliative care & advanced symptom management. Skills & experience in other areas of nursing and life will also be considered. Highly developed communication skills are essential.

Salary is paid under the Ipswich Hospice Enterprise Agreement 2010-2012.
