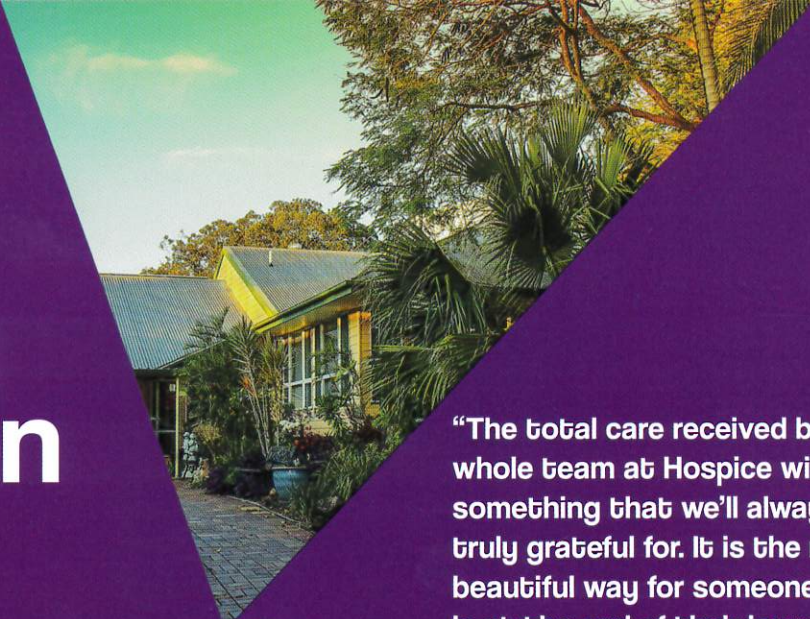




# Support a local community organisation
